Website offers info on school election

Denville: A group of Denville parents have come together to lobby voters to pass the school budget on April 15, and have launched a new website.

Residents can visit www.VoteYESforDenville.com to learn about dates, voter information and the benefits and costs to taxpayers. The group started earlier this year after concerned residents attended a board of education meeting and decided to campaign in support of the budget.

The group says it has an e-mail distribution list of more than 500 people, and will work to inform the public about the budget. School officials say that this year's \$24.7 million budget will cost the owner of the average home in Denville, assessed at \$310,000, a tax increase of about \$87 a year.
